

CITATION FOR EVELYN BROADLEY - Honour Award 2017

Eve Broadley, Hon Treasurer, was approached by Darryl Williams prior to the formation of the Society and asked would she be interested in being on a finance committee (a subcommittee of the interim Council). At that point of time she had had over 30 years' experience in stockbroking with extensive experience in management, being a 50% owner of her own firm and a former director and shareholder of a prominent West Australian broking firm. Eve was honored and happy to help and was subsequently elected to the inaugural Council as the appointed representative of the finance committee. She developed the concept of "Contributing Members" to raise funds to support the Society

Involved with the Society since its inception, Eve has served two terms as president. She took over the responsibility for the magazine in 2002 whilst in the role as president and more recently as treasurer relinquishing her role as editor in 2012. Eve continued in her role as Hon Treasurer when she became a board member of the Sphinx Foundation. She currently remains in both positions. Her involvement in the success of various functions held each year has been outstanding.

Eve's achievements to date have been considerable. She stepped into the role of the editor of the magazine when there was no one else willing to take on that role and also served a second term as president when no one else put up their hand. For some time she served as president, treasurer and magazine editor simultaneously. During her time on Council she ran her own stockbroking company until recently. She is now employed by another firm whilst at the same time being involved with her business partner in extensive agricultural interests.

Each of the positions she has undertaken have been central to the continuing development of the organization and its service to the School. Without her contribution the Modernian Society and the Sphinx Foundation would be much poorer.
